### ***Middle School Philosophy***

A middle years environment is based upon the needs and characteristics of the adolescent learner.

These characteristics must be recognized as being developmental and dynamic. Caring, trained professionals will assist the intellectual, physical, social and emotional needs of the middle years student by offering programs reflecting experiential learning, integrated curricula and opportunities to nurture positive relationships with adults and peers.

### ***Middle School Programs***

Middle schools, most commonly composed of grades six to eight, are specifically designed to address the learning needs of young people in the transition period between childhood and full adolescence. Along with the regular academic program, all of our middle years schools offer a wide range of options as well as extra-curricular activities. Hands on, active participation is encouraged in all subject areas and especially in courses such as performing and fine arts, physical education, special interests, career exploration and independent studies. Team Advisory Groups develop a sense of belonging. This group time allows staff and students to connect outside of a regular classroom setting.
